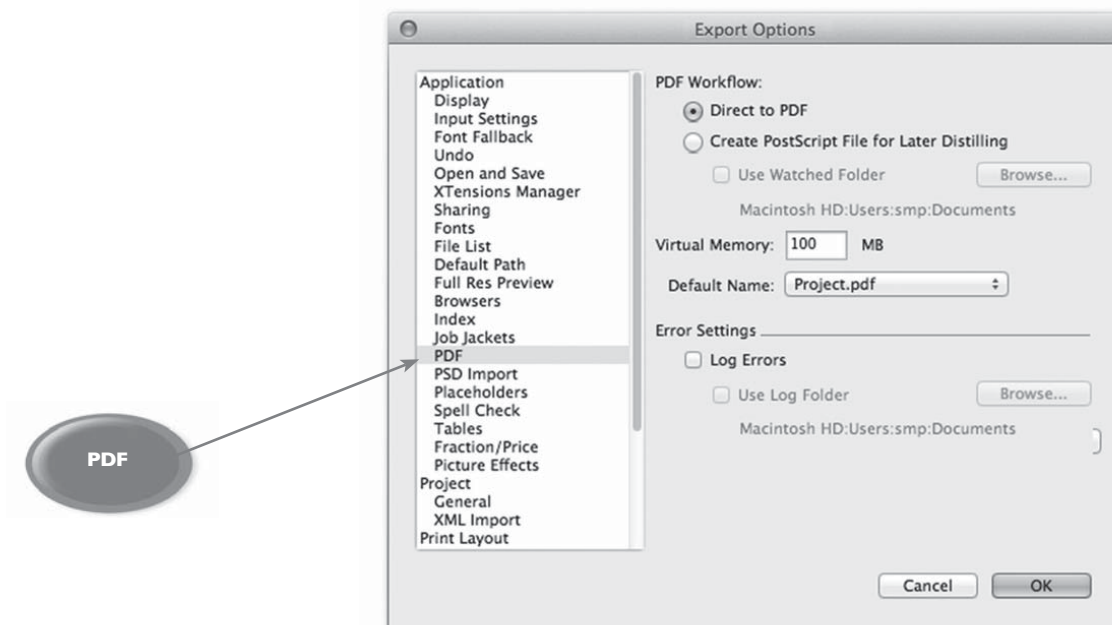


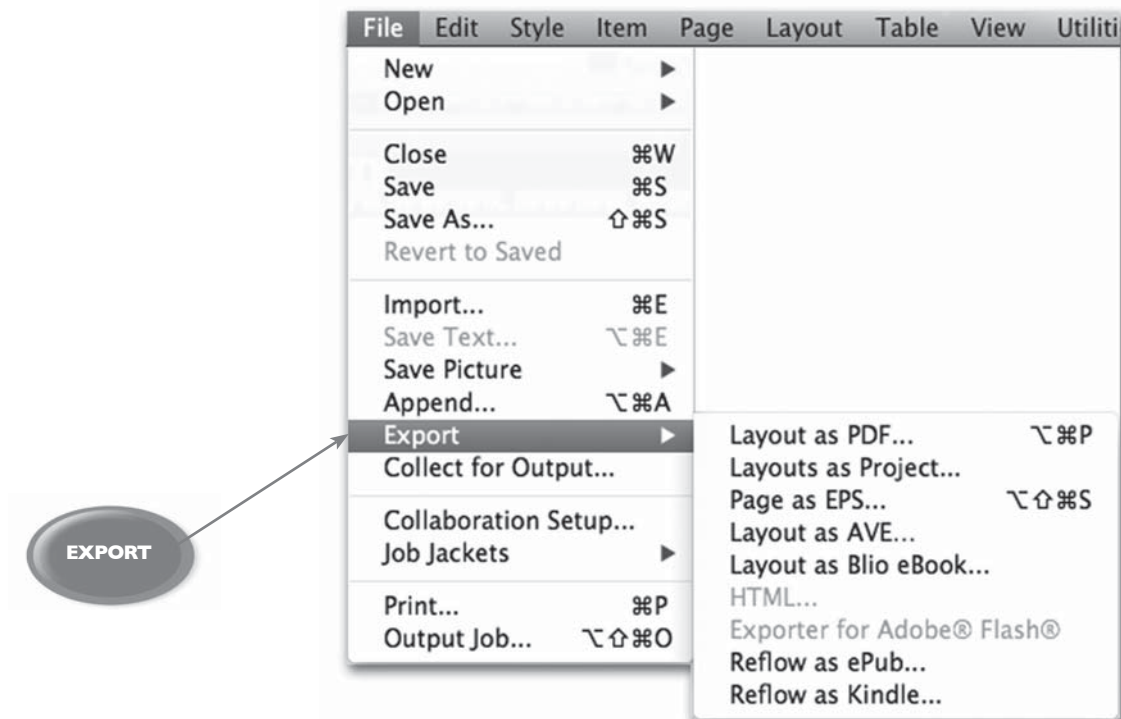
# Exporting PDF files from MAC QuarkXPress 9

Open Quark and under **QuarkXPress** from the file menu select Preferences...  
Use the following screen captures as your guide to creating a PDF.

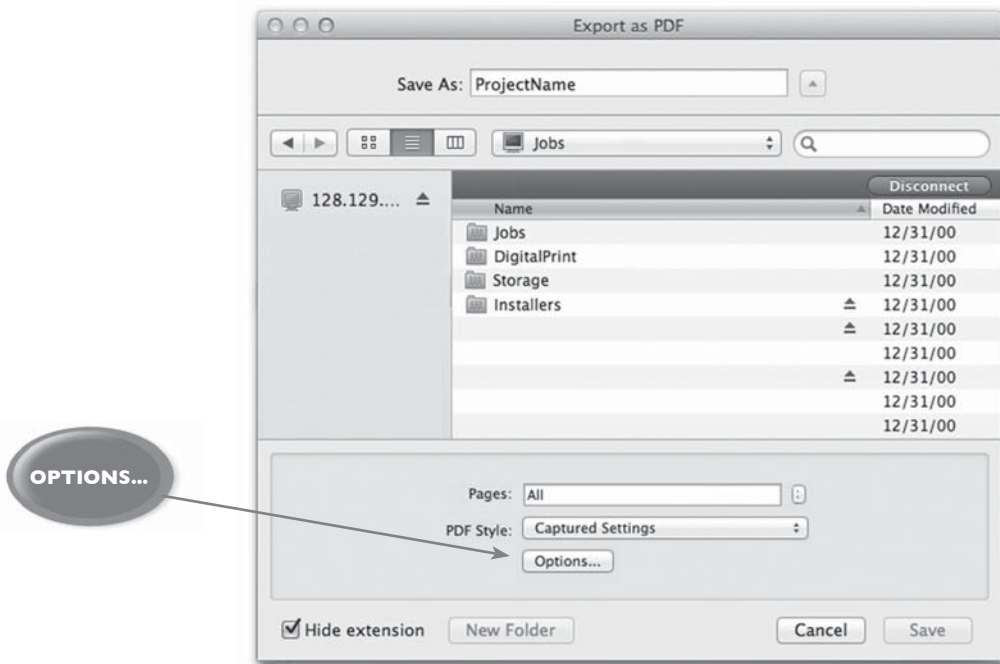
1. Click on **PDF** from the Export Options menu., then match settings as shown below,



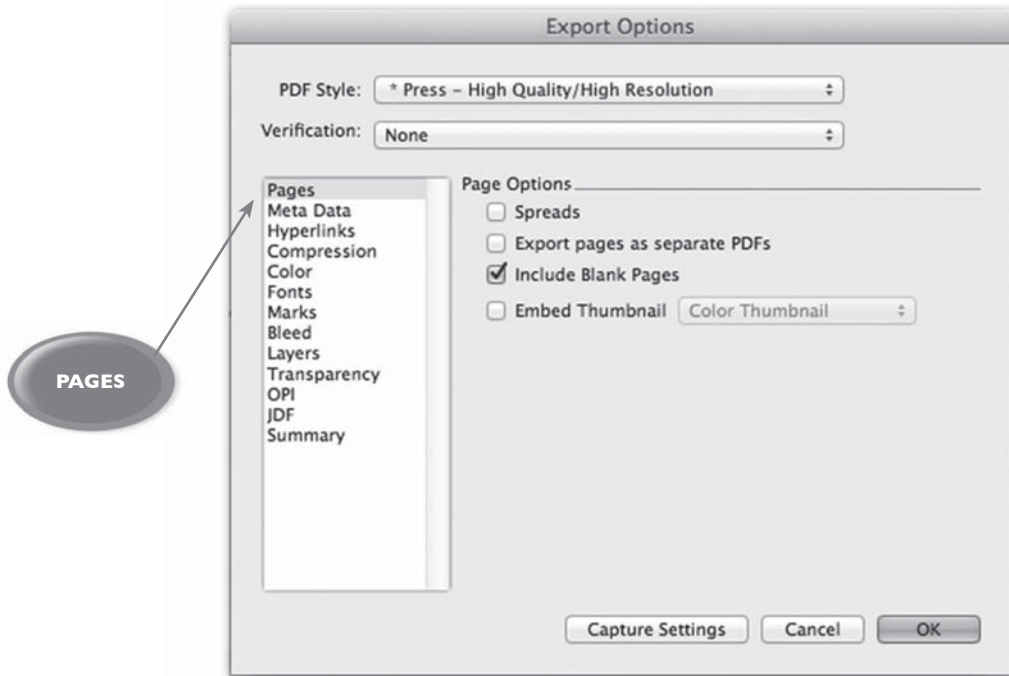
2. Go to File / Export, then select Layout as PDF...



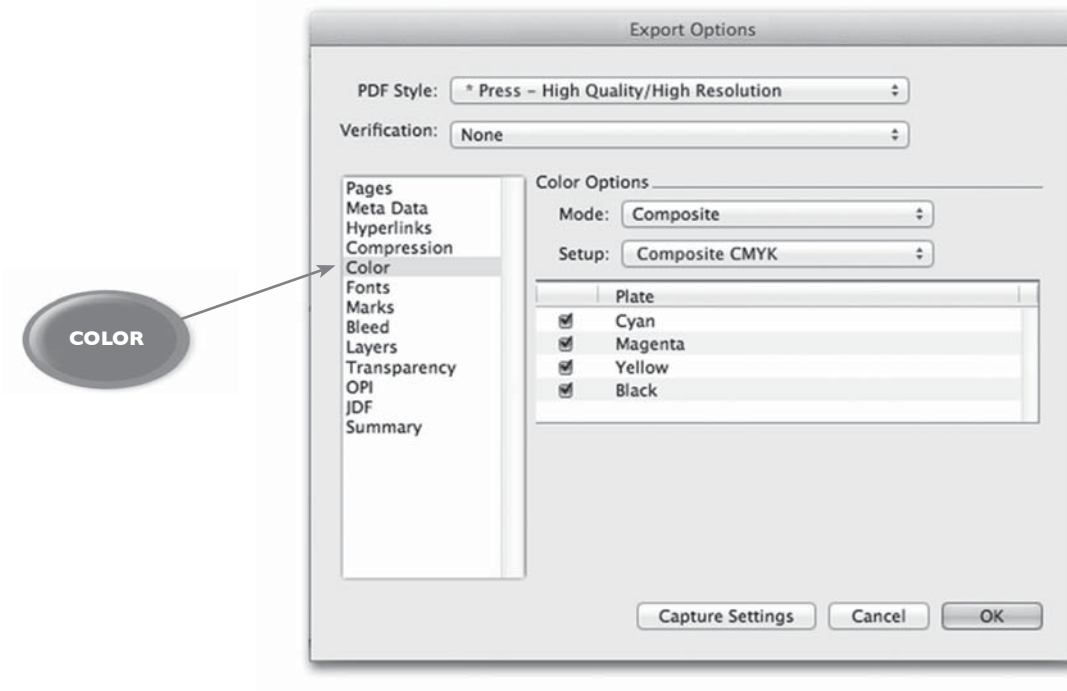
3. Give a name and location to PDF file, then click on Options....



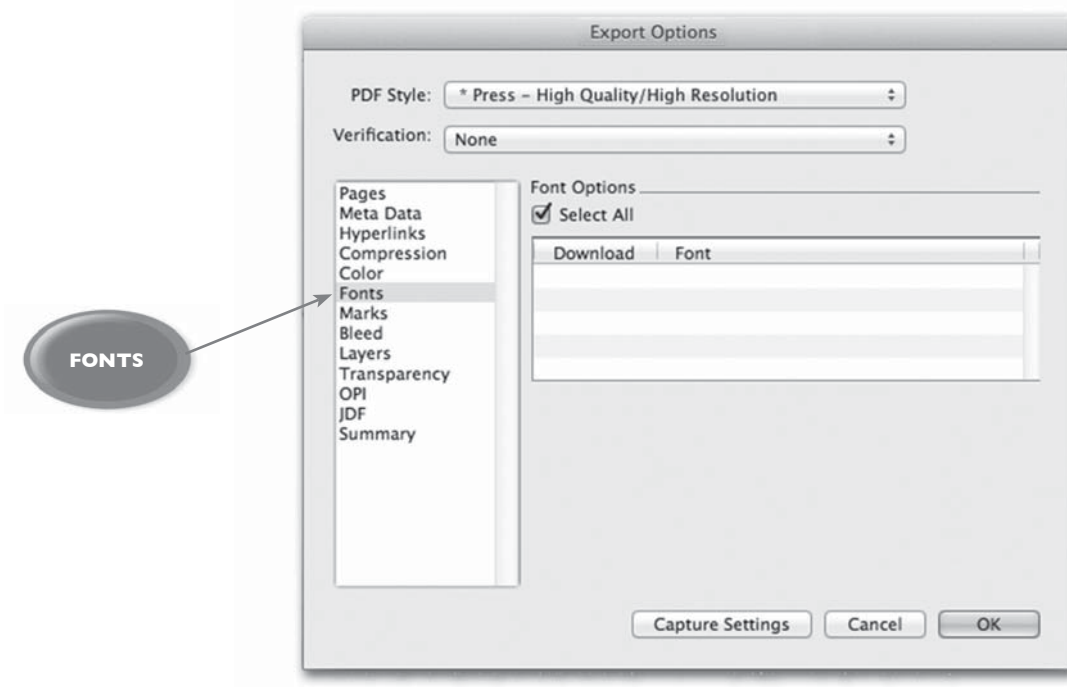
4. Select Pages, then match the settings as shown below:



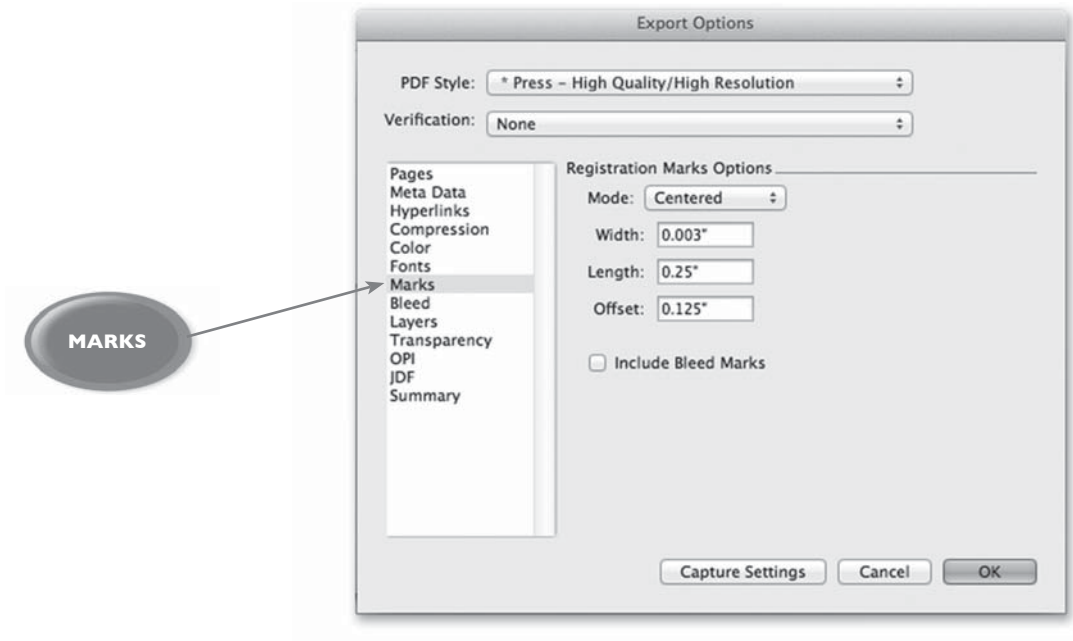
5. Select Color, then use Composite CMYK as Setup for four color process and Composite CMYK and Spot for jobs with Spot colors, then match the settings as shown below:



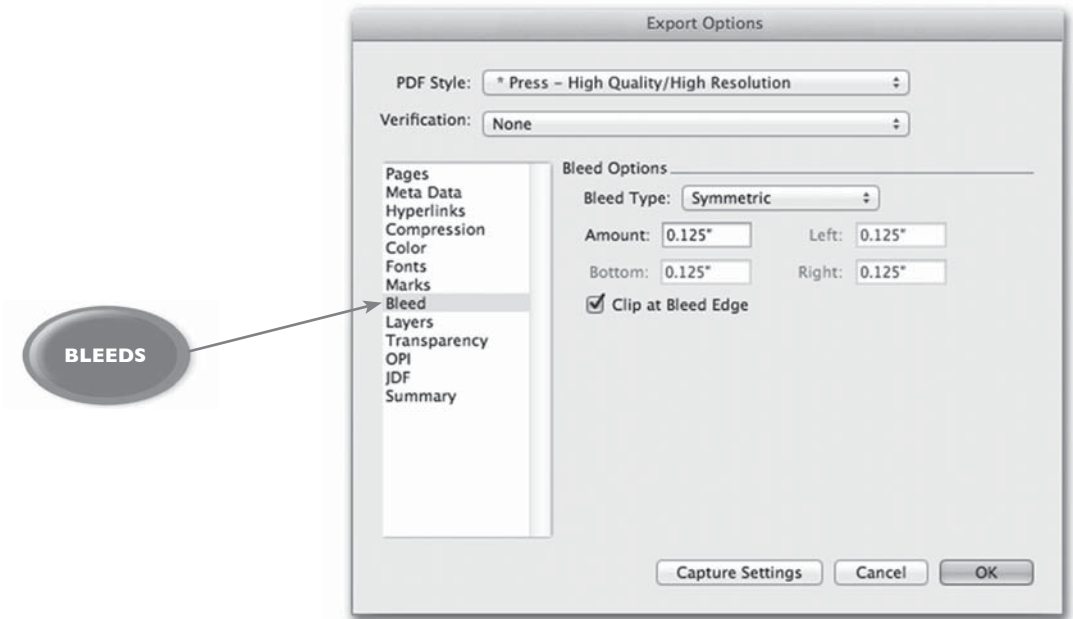
6. Select Fonts, then match the settings as shown below:



7. Select Marks, then match the settings as shown below:



8. Select Bleeds, then match the settings as shown below:



9. Leave Meta Data, Hyperlinks, Compression, Layers, transparency, OPI, JDF and any other settings as default, then click OK.
